Sustainable Procurement Policy





Scope

Gleeson Homes is committed to the sustainable building of new homes by actively managing our supply chain, materials and operations across all sites in a sustainable manner.

Purpose

To reduce the adverse impact on the environment through the use of resources, Gleeson Homes is committed to acquiring construction materials from a supply chain with a proven track record of supplying sustainably sourced materials.

Aims and objectives

- To work with our supply chain to ensure that materials are sourced in an ethically, socially responsible and sustainable manner.
- To operate a robust environmental policy and Environmental Management System (EMS) to ensure that the Group complies with all relevant environmental legislation.
- To source only sustainably certified timbers. Uncertified timber is not to be purchased or used across any development sites (see the Group's Sustainable Timber Policy).
- To include appropriate sustainability criteria in our tender documentation. Where materials can be ethically sourced a preference will be given to materials that:
 - 1. Have increased recycled content
 - 2. Minimise ecological damage
 - 3. Have low embodied carbon or have carbon off-setting policies in place
 - 4. Utilise less material by design
 - 5. Can be easily recycled
 - 6. Minimise packaging waste
 - 7. Minimise use of water
- To identify and utilise materials wherever possible which have low environmental impact or where carbon emissions can be demonstrably reduced through its use.
- To source materials, wherever possible, locally to minimise the environmental impact of transport and haulage.
- To work with our supply chain to reduce the carbon emissions from their operating activities in relation to our business.
- To communicate this Policy throughout the business to ensure compliance.
